

RESOLUTION NO. 0609-05-16

WHEREAS, the Traffic Engineering Division is working on a project to install cameras at 70 intersections in order to monitor traffic flow; and

WHEREAS, the objective of the project is to add 70 additional Pan/Tilt/Zoom (PTZ) cameras at signalized intersections throughout the City. Currently the City has 20 intersections with PTZ cameras and they are used for monitoring traffic flow and for helping with traffic signal timing. The cameras will help make City staff more efficient and help cut down on unnecessary maintenance trips to intersections; and

WHEREAS, The Iowa Department of Transportation has a contract with Electronic Technology Inc. for Axis PTZ Cameras; and

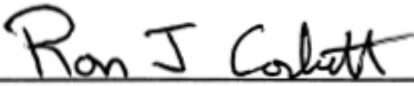
WHEREAS, Traffic Engineering is piggybacking onto this contract for the purchase of 70 Axis PTZ camera with mounting hardware and power supply for an amount not to exceed \$189,350; and

WHEREAS, a Contractor to install these cameras will be procured via a Request for Bid.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA, that the Traffic Engineering Division is authorized to purchase the Axis PTZ Cameras as described herein.
